Community Speedwatch

OPENING TIMES

Monday - Friday

You may have seen parishioners standing by the roadside with a camera from time to time. These volunteers are operating the Community Speedwatch (CSW) programme, a scheme co-ordinated by Northamptonshire Police.

Traffic through Evenley has increased over the years as more people use it as a cut-through but worse, many are driving too fast for a rural village with a 30mph speed limit, putting pedestrians and pets at risk.

CSW has been running in the village for ten years and motorists driving at 35mph or higher are reported to Northamptonshire Police. The Police then issue offenders a warning letter. A second offence or more may result in further action.

During the 14 sessions undertaken between 28 May and 23 June 2023, the team recorded 154 offenders, with the highest speed recorded being 60mph.

Many of the volunteers on the CSW have supported the programme from the start and over time have reduced in number. In the early years we were able to support daily sessions, but we just don't have enough people to do that anymore. Please consider supporting CSW, which runs for a month once a year. Each session is for one hour with flexible time schedules. Volunteers are given training and you will always be in a group with experienced team members. Please contact the speed watch co-ordinator, Zelda Carr on zelda@cqc-ltd.com, if you are able to help, or need further information.

Evenley Parish Council fully supports Community Speedwatch and thanks all the volunteers for their help in keeping our village safe.
