AD UPDATE

The officer in charge of the planning application for an anaerobic digestion plant to be built in Evenley confirms that it is a major application and as such requires an enormous amount of work to be undertaken before a recommendation is put to the planning committee. The officer advises that the applicant has been asked to supply further information and so does not foresee a decision being made before the end of the year. As soon as a date is known, EPC will be sending representatives to the planning meeting to put forward the views of the majority of residents.

Budget news

Evenley Parish Council is working on its budget for next year (from April 2023). There will be a small increase to the precept of about five per cent, which equates to an extra £4.18 a year for a band D household. This increase will cover the rising costs we are all experiencing and allow us to protect the funds we've been building up to reinvest in the parish. Should funds allow, next year we hope to improve the quality of the village green.

After the worst drought this country has seen for over 40 years, the Green is in a poor state of repair. From early Spring EPC will be undertaking a series of measures to repair the damage and protect and improve it for the future. Such a programme hasn't been undertaken for a number of years and benefits won't be seen instantly but the parish council believes the village green is Evenley's main asset and is in desperate need of some care and attention. Parts of the Green may have to be roped off temporarily but all activities will be communicated with residents well in advance.


